<p>Business management training for managers of water companies -- Vietnam, 2011</p> 	<p>The government of Vietnam has planned a large scale improvement of urban water and sanitation for the whole country. Capacity building of Vietnamese water sector staff is a crucial factor to maintain and sustain the investments. After a final assessment the general conclusion is that special attention is needed for business management training, including amongst others the fields of human resources management, asset management (including operation and maintenance) and quality management.</p> <p>World Water Academy and DHV teamed up in this capacity building program to combine the Dutch expertise on water supply and sewerage together with capacity building. Main aim is to develop and implement a business management training curriculum for managers of water supply and sewerage companies in Vietnam. In addition, a plan will be designed to sustain the courses for the Vietnamese water sector.</p>	<p>Partners for Water (NL - financier)</p> <p>DHV B.V. <p>Capacity building for water companies in the Mekong Delta -- Ho Chi Minh City, 2006-2008</p>  	<p>Currently, the Mekong Delta Region with its 20 million inhabitants is developing rapidly. The quality of the drinking-water supply is poor and the distribution system leakage is high. A shortage of educated water specialists at all levels is expected. Training and human resource development is seen as an important factor to improve the water supply and sanitation up to a sustainable situation. So, the Vietnam Water Association wants to set up an institutional centre to train skillful manpower for water utilities in the Mekong Delta.</p> <p>World Water Academy and A4A initiated a project to establish a Mekong Delta Region Water Training Centre following the SWO-concept. Together with the VWSA two pilot courses were organized. In total 48 professionals are trained in distribution and production, as well as being a trainer. The new trained trainers will teach in the trainings and courses set up by the Training Centre. A fully “Vietnamese” course with Vietnamese programme and topics, Vietnamese trainers and organization was part of the project.
